General Concepts...

Cue bid implies a fit... shows opening Pts with no clear cut direction...

We will always be counting shortness (dummy pts) when valuing our hand for supporting partner's suit...

Void=5 ... X=3... XX=1

After an intervening Bid ...

Single Raise= 3/4+ pts and at least a "limited fit" (xx) A stinky "Garbage " raise Double Raise is Constructive (7 w/xxxx or 8-9 pts)

Cue Bid Shows Limit raise or better...10+ support pts and Trump Support...as follows... C=xxxxx D=xxxx S=xxx H=xxx

After an intervening Double ...

We will always overbid by 1 level.. after a Double...

General concepts...overbidding at the 2 Level and 3 Level

1S...X.....2S=Partner I have 2-3 S..Weak raise..Use best judgment of situation to decide how weak!

1S...X.....3S=Partner I have 3 S..Regular single raise 5-9 pts

2NT=Limit raise 10-11...... 3NT=Jacoby Forcing Raise (can be done with only 3 trumps after interference...)

Defending against Pre-empts...

Over Opponent's Weak 2 Bid Opener...Bid = 12-15X = 15

Over Opponent's 3 Level Opener.....Bid =14-16 X =17+

Special Carding...

The Opening Lead of a Queen...promises the Jack or a singleton...
